



London Marathon – 1995

LONDON PRIDE FOR BARNSELEY ATHLETES

Pete Pleasants of Barnsley AC turned in a magnificent performance to take 46th place in the London Marathon on Sunday with a personal best time of 2-24-07. Up against 26,000 other runners, including many internationals, he was, in fact, the 15th British runner home – a great achievement for a Barnsley athlete.

Neil Moore was 91st in 2-29-19; Robert Elstone 96th in a personal best of 2-30-38, and Steve Timmons took 128th spot, also in a personal best time of 2-33-06, to help Barnsley to the second team award behind Basildon with an aggregate time of 9-57-12. So both individually and collectively it was a memorable day for the Barnsley club.

Other Barnsley AC leading times and positions were: 188, Chris McLoughlin 2-36-30; 305, Steve Winslow 2-40-32; 609 Roy Hart 2-47-55(pb). Sue Endersby was 42nd lady in 3-3-30 while Christine Denton game home in 3-13-21. Barry Bedford clocked 3-30-48 in his 125th marathon, Ken Sone finished in 3-35 in his 50th and Sandra Platts recorded 4-20.
